ROAD DEPARTMENT:

Tom Lalonde, Road Department, reported on the following: Road mowing completed for year; F450 is back from Valley Ford, repairs have been completed; 2 dump trucks and backhoe are prepped for winter weather; salt shed is full; crack sealed inner sections along Darrow Road (Barnes, Frailey, S. Poorman) which was recently paved and new culvert on Cherry Road; and Ashmont Road Culvert project has been completed.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION:

Tim Costello, resident, discussed the donation given to the City for redoing the playground equipment at Sherod Park and asked if the township could participate in some way whether it be a financial donation or material and/or equipment. He also inquired about a previous discussion regarding a possible ice-skating rink on Barnes Road in the township and stated he developed and ran the skating rink in the city. Mr. Costello volunteered his expertise and time if there was any interest in the idea.

Rodger Scott, resident, brought up for discussion security lights that appear to be staying on all day and night and asked if they could be turned off during the day. He also discussed a sign that was near Pat O'Brien Chevrolet that has been down for quite a while (little island with elevated concrete) and asked if the Board could look into that since when snow appears on ground the concrete will no longer be visible and is elevated more that the state route. Mr. Scott stated there could be some possible accidents due to this issue. Mr. Scott also discussed a possible turn in on State Route 60 by the schools to allow for better traffic flow. and he would like to investigate some of these issues now, which would make things easier for the community in the future.

Chris Ksenich inquired about a security light being placed on the west side of the older township garage building since it's dark in that area.
